

## Give through your Employer with Matching Gifts

- **Bank of America:** Bank of America offers its full-time and part-time employees, as well as active members of its Board of Directors an opportunity to match gifts to eligible non-profits if the donation is \$24 or more. - **Caterpillar:** Each Caterpillar participant may request an annual combined total maximum match of \$2,000 in each calendar year. Participants must submit matching gift requests online by January 31 of the year following the donation. - **COUNTRY Financial:** COUNTRY Financial employees (financial reps/agents not eligible), along with employees of the Illinois Farm Bureau and IAA Credit Union, have access to a donation match program. Up to \$500 per employee, per year can be matched when a personal donation is made to an eligible nonprofit organization. Employees can simply visit their internal benefits page, search GIVING & find more details (including how to fill out the request form). Matching donations can be requested until between January 1 to December 2 each year.
- **Exelon Corporation:** Exelon offers full-time and part-time employees an opportunity to match gifts of \$25 or more up to \$2,000 per year. Exelon matches gifts to arts and cultural organizations. - **General Electric** offers matching for full-time and part-time staff and retirees who registered prior to April 15, 2020. They will match gifts of \$25 or more up to \$5,000 per year. - **State Farm Insurance Company:** With their Matching Gift Program, State Farm matches up to \$5,000 per calendar year for eligible non-profit organizations. Employees, agents and retirees can get details from [www.cybergrants.com/statefarm/gives](http://www.cybergrants.com/statefarm/gives).
